15 Ways to Give Your Kitchen a Deep Clean for Spring

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Sink and Disposal

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Using a paste made from baking soda and water, wipe generously all over to clean a stainless steel sink. If you have a disposal, throw in a couple of ice cubes and a quartered lemon, which will clean the blades and squelch any odours.

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
